

Trash

“Hazardous material: Any chemical which poses a hazard to health, property, or the environment **shall not** be deliberately discarded with the general waste or by any route into the sanitary sewer system.” JHU Policy Laboratory waste disposal HSE805

- **liquids**

- trash liquids should be kept in closed “waste bottles” labeled with a sticker indicating product, manufacturer, the start date, and your name.

- **solids**

- Create a labeled trash box/beaker clearly identified as TRASH or WASTE indicating the name of the product and your name.
- Any contaminated solids (INCLUDING GLOVES) should be left to evaporate under the hood for at least 48h (longer if you think it is necessary).

- After evaporation, they can be placed in the biohazard trashcan.



**DO NOT mix products in the trash
(solid or liquid)
DO NOT put liquids in the Biohazard
trashcan**
