## Required Introductory Courses

#### **EN.500.603** Graduate Orientation and Academic Ethics

- 20-minute online tutorial
- Students will be registered and notified when available.
- Must complete in first semester. Don't wait!

#### **Responsible Conduct of Research**

- AS.360.624 MSE 2-hours; complete in first semester
- AS.360.625 PhD, some MSE with NIH research 10-hours; complete in first year
- Offered all semesters and summer



#### **Intermediate Laboratory Safety**

- 8 online modules are <u>required</u>
- In-person EN.500.601 Research Laboratory Safety class is <u>optional</u>.
- Must take modules before starting any kind of research.





### MSE Degree Requirements - 30 credits

#### Section A – A set of advisor-approved courses – 24 credits or more

- 6 courses total 18 credits or more each 3 credits or more
- **2-4 more courses** total 6 credits 1.5-3 credits each from Center for Leadership Education or other departments
- Also...
  - 2 must be applied math, numerical analysis, or computational
  - Almost half must be 530.xxx or 535.xxx Mechanical Engineering
  - Up to 2 from Engineering for Professionals
  - Up to 4 upper-undergrad level
  - No independent research, graduate research, or special studies.

#### Section B – choose one option – 6 more credits

- All-Course 2 more courses 3 credits 530.823 MSE Graduate Research can be one
- Master's Essay 6 credits either <u>530.822 MSE Essay Co-Op</u> or <u>530.823 MSE Graduate Research</u>

### PhD Degree Requirements

#### **Mechanical Engineering**

- No specific course requirements only suggestions
- Pass the Departmental Qualifier Exam (DQE) Year 1
- Submit dissertation proposal Year 3
- Teaching Assistant 2 courses
- Register for and pass EN.530.801 Graduate Research every semester
- Register for and pass EN.530.803 MechE Graduate Seminar
  - first three years
- Maintain academic and research performance

#### University

- 2 semesters of "full-time" residency
- Pass the Graduate Board Oral (GBO) exam
- Submit and defend dissertation







- > Base stipend of \$50,000 (increased from an avg of \$34,000 in 2023)
